David H. Bailey has been the Director of the Hollis Town Band for the past five years. In addition to his duties as music director, he is also the conductor of the Nashua Flute Choir. David currently teaches band and music classes at the Nashua Catholic Regional Schools, while maintaining a private teaching studio and instrument repair shop. He resides in Nashua with his wife, Alison, a violinist, and their son Seth.

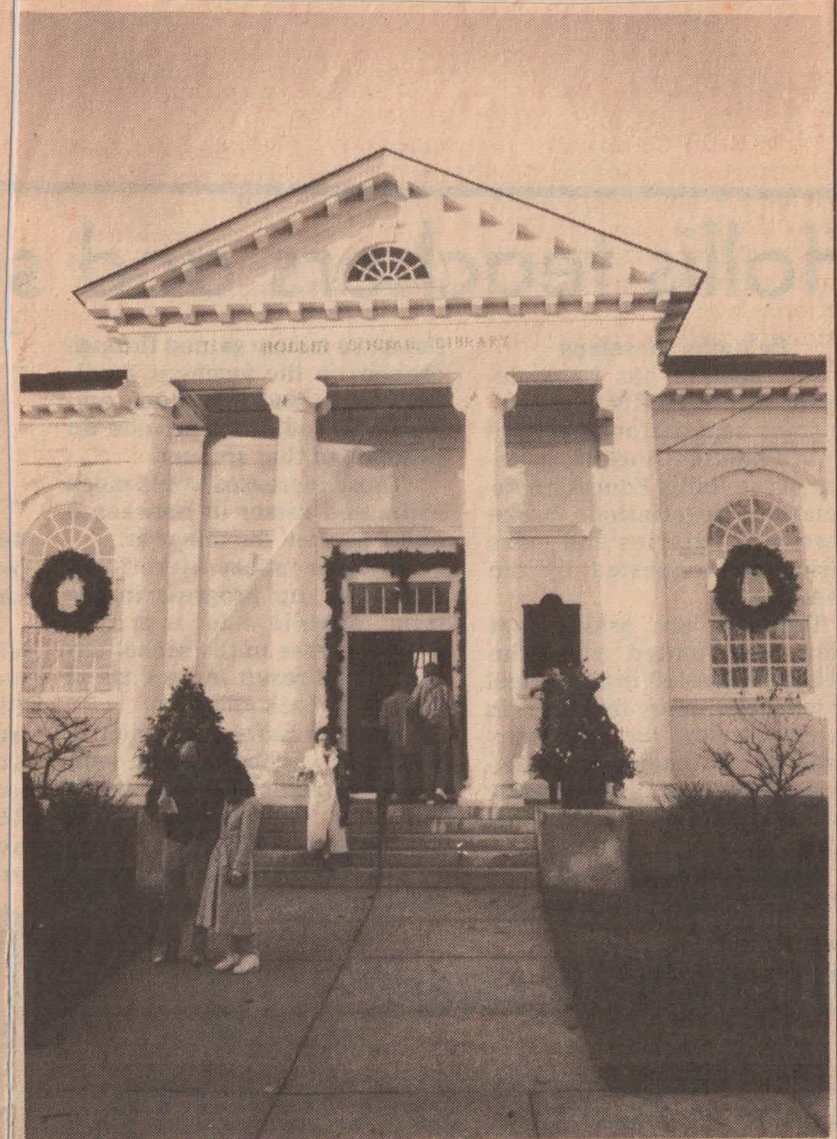
