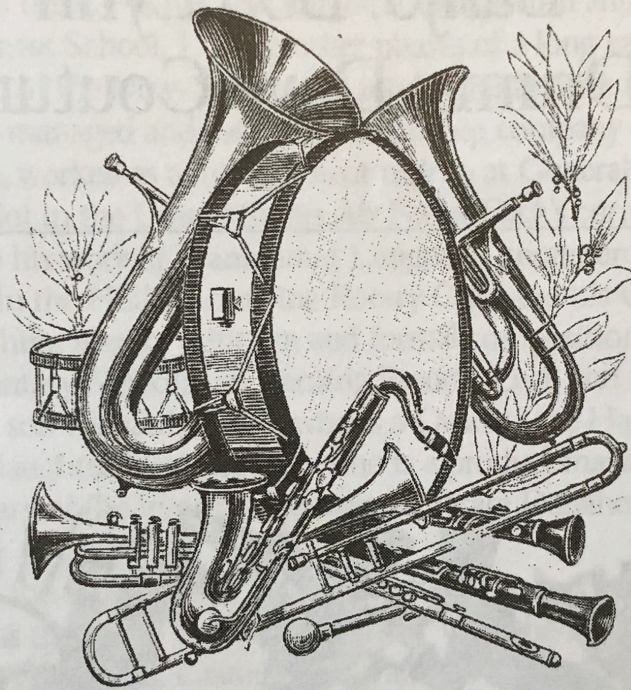

Soloist Biographies

Richard Mills

Dick Mills and his wife, Demaris, have been residents of Hollis for 25 years, having moved their small consulting business here from New York. Dick is presently the Chief Information Officer (CIO) and a Board member of Transparent Language, Inc., a Nashua-based language and technology company. Born in Birmingham, Alabama, Dick's career has been varied. He comes from academic roots, having earned three degrees from MIT and been both a faculty member and a member of the senior administration there. He has also taught at Dartmouth and at the Harvard Business School. During other phases of a long career Dick served as CIO of the New-York-based international bank now known as Citigroup, co-managed and sold a small start-up company headquartered on Route 128, worked as a management trainee at General Electric, and served as a pilot in the United States Air Force. Dick's current activities, in addition to his work at Transparent Language, center around his membership in the Hollis Brookline Rotary Club and his volunteer activities teaching literary criticism and formal composition in the Hollis Upper Elementary School, and learning French.
